In terms of year 7 coming in September 2016-2017 below expected standard majority have pupils have made progress. Please see below:

Numeracy	For years 7 and 8 Numeracy lessons have been timetabled into the curriculum for each of the set 4 groups from Maths. This stands at 1 hour per week.	8 pupils entered below an Old level 4 with one pupil on a level 2. 75% were assessed at Level 4 at the end of year 7. 12.5% who entered on 2a made a whole level of progress while the other 12.5% made 2 sub levels to a 3a but was still below L4. however both pupil are now assessed at L4.
